## Embedding a Kaltura Video




<u>Job Aid Objective</u>: Provide faculty with the steps associated with embedding a Kaltura video into a course. Kaltura is video hosting program that is integrated with our LMS, Blackboard. It allows faculty and students to easily create and share their own video media.

*Please note*: A Kaltura video can be embedded anywhere you have a visual editor in Blackboard. This includes the following areas:


- Assignment Submission
- Threaded Discussion Response
- Essay Test Responses
- Blogs and Wikis

\*The **My Media** module on Blackboard homepage is *only* available for faculty. Students access their media repository from the Mash-up tool in the visual text editor.


**Step 1**: After you have created your Kaltura video and are ready to embed your video into your course, click on the **MashUp** tool located in the third row of the visual editor tool bar. Then, select the **Kaltura Media** option.



Step 2: A new window will open and you will select the video from My Media.



**Step 3**: The video will now be embedded in your visual editor. You may choose to resize the video by double-clicking the image and dragging the corner with your cursor.



Step 4: Click Submit



Your media will now be embedded into the content item. You can embed your media any other place in Blackboard that you have access to the Visual Editor.
